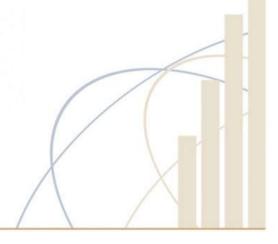

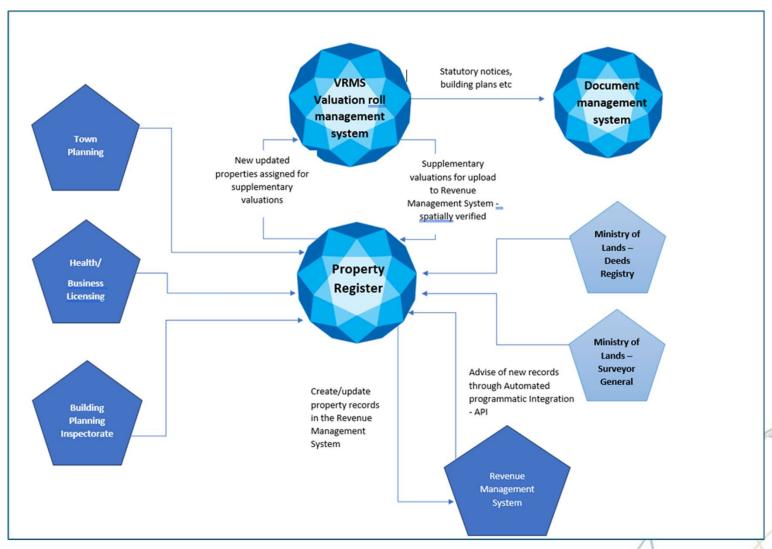
The value of the current Valuation Roll



- Municipalities spend millions on the preparation of valuation rolls - only to bill incorrectly or to collect at low levels
- Valuation rolls are often treated as static records
- Valuation rolls should be dynamic and used proactively
- Maintaining the current valuation roll drives planning (infrastructure charges), development and financial sustainability
- Valuation Roll maintenance is a team effort: Town
 Planning, Building Inspectorate, Valuers, Finance, etc

Consequences of Underutilisation



- Discrepancies: Mis-aligned billing
- National Treasury Valuation Roll reconciliation report mSCOA quarterly report
- Revenue leakage/Loss of revenue
- Public mistrust/Undermines municipal credibility
- Leads to disputes and delayed revenue
- If the valuation roll is not maintained the municipality is not treating the ratepayers equitably.
- Triggers political backlash

Accurate Billing Builds Trust





Accurate Billing Builds Trust



- Accounts that make sense = Better payment & more trust
- Align current valuation roll (Part A of the property register) with the spatial property register and financial system
- Monthly reconciliations are key
- API's between the VRMS and the financial system must pick up the burden of these monthly reconciliations.

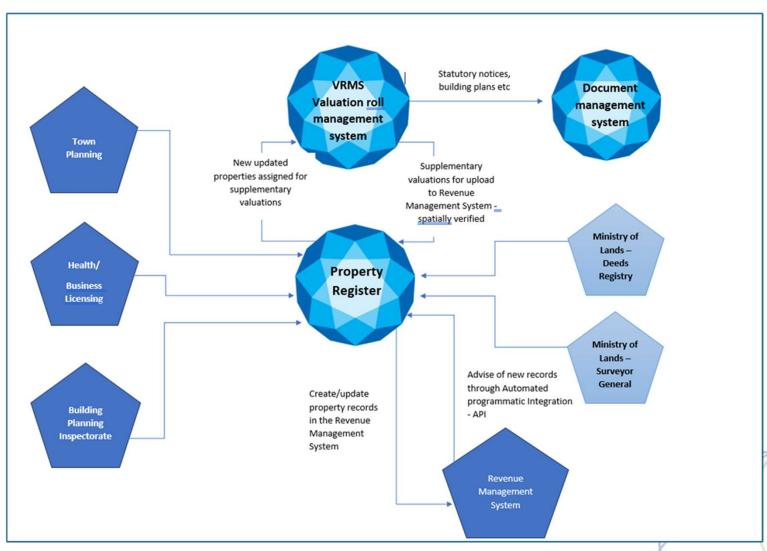

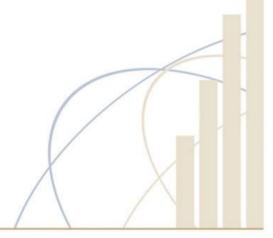
Using geospatial reporting tools to manage your property data:

- Integrate GIS (spatial property register) and billing through APIs
- Automated reconciliations flagging of discrepancies
- Mapping properties owned by indigent households
- Where are your debtors? Which area/ward is not paying and why?
- Are your vacant properties really vacant? Land audits
- Utility consumption vs debtors
